Attendance: Each student's success in the course is dependent on them being in class. I will take roll until the add deadline. The student may be dropped from the course if:

- (1) Their absences exceeds one before or on the add deadline.

Homework: I will assign homework **daily**. Each student is responsible for completing their homework **prior** to the next class meeting. Homework will be collected during the first 5 minutes of class on **Monday** and **Wednesday**. Any assignments turned in after 5 minutes will be worth half the graded score. **No assignments will be accepted** after the class period has ended on Monday or Wednesday. The assignment will be graded on completeness and will be worth 20 points. The lowest homework score will be dropped when calculating the final grade.

Quizzes: We will have a 10 minute quiz every **Monday** and **Wednesday** at the beginning of the class session (except on exam days). Quizzes **will not** be administered during the last 2 minutes of the quiz. You may not make up any missed quizzes. The lowest quiz score will be dropped when calculating the final grade.

Exams: We will have **2 exams** throughout the semester. **No makeup** exams will be given during the semester, in the event that your final exam percent is higher than any exam percent, I will replace your lowest exam percent with your final exam percent.
